Mr. Tahamtanzadeh has more than 16-years of experience in the diagnostic and biotechnology industry. He started his career as an R&D chemist developing immunodiagnostic assays for drugs of abuse testing and therapeutic drug monitoring and later moved into corporate sales and other entrepreneurial positions where he held various business management responsibilities implementing sales, business development and marketing strategies that led to meeting targeted revenues for many startup and public companies including Intergen Company, Pyrosequencing, MetriGenix, IGEN International, Fisher Scientific, Beckman Coulter and most recently Ventana Medical Systems.

At Ventana, Mr. Tahamtanzadeh successfully directed the domestic and international business development activities that included managing major pharmaceutical and biotechnology alliances with a focus on premier oncology companies.
